Shopping online for fertility medicines has never been easier...or riskier.

These days it seems we turn to the Internet for just about everything.

Sometimes we shop online to save money. Other times we do it because it's just more convenient.


But buying fertility medicines online has never been riskier.

There are more than 35,000 online pharmacies at any given time, but only 1,400 of those sites are safe and legal. That means that you can't trust 96% of online pharmacies.

Are the risks that bad? Yes, they are.

Dealing with
multiple treatment
options and
cycles is difficult enough – often
it's a process of elimination. With
the significantly increased risk of
uncertain levels of active and/or correct
pharmaceutical ingredients, it makes
the process of eliminating non-successful
treatment options all the more difficult.

If you order from an illegal online pharmacy, the drugs you receive may contain too much, too little, a completely different or no active ingredient at all. These products often aren't stored properly or may contain harmful, and sometimes deadly, poisons such as paint thinner, arsenic and floor wax. There will be no way for you to know that. It's not worth it.



How do I protect myself?

The easiest way to stay safe is to only buy fertility medicines from your specialty pharmacy. If you are going to shop online, however, please verify your pharmacy website is safe and legal before you buy by visiting www.BuySafeRx.pharmacy.

And please, never buy from an online pharmacy that

- Doesn't require a valid prescription
- Doesn't have a physical street address in the U.S.
- Doesn't have a licensed pharmacist on staff
- Sends unsolicited emails
- Ships medications worldwide

Is it safe to buy my fertility medicines from IVFMeds. com, fertilitydrugsonline. com, ivf.towndrugstore.com or ivfprescriptions.com?

No it isn't.

These sites offer worldwide shipping of prescription products in violation of numerous countries' applicable laws, provide no evidence of having valid pharmacy licenses, and/or do not disclose the location of the pharmacy itself. They are unsafe, so please don't use them!



Are Canadian online pharmacies safe? No, they aren't.

Most of the thousands of sites claiming to be Canadian have no connection to Canada at all. In fact, there's almost a 100% chance that the medicine you think is coming from Canada is actually coming from another country where you wouldn't even drink the water. Do you want to take that chance?
